

**BYLAW #2017-800
VILLAGE OF CARBON
IN THE
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND UTILITIES BYLAW #2016-792 FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARBON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Village of Carbon has adopted Utilities Bylaw #2016-792.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Carbon deems it desirable to amend Utilities Bylaw #2016-792; and,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Carbon hereby amends Utilities Bylaw #2016-792 as follows.

1. Schedule "A" is amended as per attached Schedule "A"
2. Section 10 is amended by adding sections 10.4.1 and 10.4.2 as follows,
 - 10.4.1 For the purpose of this bylaw, Village water meters shall be considered part of the municipal utility service and shall not be tampered with, altered or bypassed in any way.
 - 10.4.2 The owner of the property where a water meter is found to have been tampered with, altered or "bypassed" in any way, shall be liable for the fine as outlined in Schedule "B" in addition to any costs incurred by the Village to repair or replace said water meter.
3. Section 13.5 is amended as follows

If the Village turns off the water supply to any account due to nonpayment, that account shall incur disconnection and reconnection fees as outlined in **Schedule "A"** of this bylaw. In this case the water shall not be turned on again until the account in question has been paid in full, including penalties, disconnect fees, reconnection fees and all current charges.



Schedule A

As at the passing of this bylaw, the rates effective January 1, 2018,-are as follows:

Water Rates:

- a) Flat \$30.00 Bi-monthly Administration and Maintenance fee
- b) For the first five thousand gallons (5000), or the metric equivalent of twenty-two point seventy-three (22.73) cubic meters or less, of water consumed, the rate of charge shall be:
 - One hundred dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$100.37) bi-monthly;
- c) For use over five thousand gallons (5000), or the metric equivalent of twenty-two point seventy-three (22.73) cubic meters, the rate of charge shall be:
 - Twenty dollars and six cents (\$20.06) per one thousand gallons (1000), or the metric equivalent of Four dollars and forty-two cents (\$4.42) per cubic meter
- d) Disconnect water service due to non-payment of account \$50.00
- e) Connect water service due to non-payment of account \$50.00
- f) Disconnect water service for accounts on inactive status \$20.00
- g) Reconnect water service for accounts on inactive status \$20.00

Sewer Rates:

- a) Single Residence 34.10 bi-monthly
- b) Churches/Halls 43.45 bi-monthly
- c) Commercial Businesses 43.45 bi-monthly
- d) Commercial with wash bays/laundry 54.18 bi-monthly
- e) Hotels 198.00 bi-monthly
- f) Schools 233.48 bi-monthly
- g) Apartments/Lodges 34.10 bi-monthly
- h) Any other not specified 34.10 bi-monthly

Waste Collection Rates:

- a) All serviced addresses 18.50 bi-monthly

Penalties:

- a) Late payment of utility invoices 5% of outstanding balance
- b) Fee to transfer Utility Arrears to Tax Account \$40.00 per occurrence
