**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CARBON IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO
CONTROL AND REGULATE NOISE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to and with the authority of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta 1994 Chapter M-26.1, and any amendments thereto, Council hereby enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Noise Control Bylaw" of the Village of Carbon.
2. No person shall make, continue to make, cause or permit any prohibited noise within the Village of Carbon. Prohibited noise means any sound which annoys or disturbs persons or injures, endangers or detracts from the comfort, repose, health peace or safety of persons.
3. No person shall knowingly allow a prohibited noise to emanate from lands or premises of which the person is a registered owner or is under the person's control or management within the Village.
4. This provision of this bylaw does not apply to:
 - emergency vehicles
 - construction of Village approved development between the hours of 07:01 and 22:00
 - The use of motorized garden tools for less than three (3) hours during the daytime.
 - Cultural or recreational activities sanctioned by the Village
5. This bylaw shall come into effect on the date of final reading.





