TAX NOTICE & PROPERTY ASSESSMENT

TAX INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PROGRAM (TIPPS)

For those property owners that are on the Tax Installment Payment Program (TIPPS), refer to the Installment Amount Beginning Jul 01, 2020 for your July 1 to December 1, 2020 payment.

For your July 1 payment, please make the payment changes if you are paying online or through your banking institution. If you pay by cheque, please drop cheques off to the Village Office at your earliest convenience.

Due to COVID-19, the Village of Carbon has removed the 9% tax penalty that is applied on outstanding balances as of August 1, 2020. The 18% tax penalty will remain on outstanding balances as of December 31, 2020.

LAND USE BYLAW AND DEVELOPMENT PERMITS

Summer is the season for property renovations and upgrades, so please contact the Village Office or visit our website at www.villageofcarbon.com to review the Land Use Bylaw 2018-804 before proceeding. The Village of Carbon refers to the Land Use Bylaw (LUB) for allowances and the Municipal Planning Commission (MPC) for any project that falls under discretionary use.

OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS

Private, outdoor, above ground, swimming pools over 2 feet in height must have a 6 foot fence with locking gate or a protective cover that has a lockable device to prevent access to the water by unauthorized persons. Development and Building Permit must be completed prior to setting up the above mentioned pool.
