



**BYLAW 2021-851
DESIGNATED OFFICER
VILLAGE OF CARBON
IN THE
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CARBON, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN DESIGNATED OFFICER POSITIONS AND TO ESTABLISH A FRAMEWORK FOR DELEGATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and any amendments thereto, Council may by Bylaw establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties and functions of a Designated Officer under this or any other enactment;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Carbon is desirous of creating Designated Officer positions for the Assessor and the Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Carbon, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Title

- a. This Bylaw may be cited as the "**Designated Officer**" Bylaw.

2. Interpretation:

- a. "**Bylaw**" means a bylaw of the Village of Carbon.
- b. "**Designated Officer**" shall mean a person appointed by the Council of the Village of Carbon to the position established by this bylaw.
- c. "**Chief Administrative Officer**" means the person appointed by Council pursuant to the Municipal Government Act.
- d. "**Council**" means the municipal council of the Village of Carbon.
- e. "**Village**" means the Village of Carbon.

3. Designated Officer

- a. The following Designated Officer position is established and the person appointed to this position will have the following title:
 - i. **BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:** To carry out the powers, duties and functions under the Municipal Government Act, Weed and Pest Control Act or any other Act and those powers, duties and functions assigned by the Chief Administrative Officer.

- b. Council will, by resolution, appoint individuals to the Designated Officer positions established by this bylaw.
- c. All Designated Officers are subject to the supervision of and accountable to the Chief Administrative Officer for the exercise of their powers, duties and functions.
- d. The appointment of the Designated Officers may be revoked by Council under the provisions of the MGA, Section 211.

4. Severability

- a. Should any provision of this Bylaw be found invalid, the invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

5. Repeal of Bylaw

- a. That Bylaw 2006-749 and all amendments thereto be hereby repealed.

6. Effective Date

- a. This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect, on the date of third and final reading.

READ a First time in Council this 11th day of February 2021.

READ a Second time in Council this 11th day of February 2021.

MOVED UNANIMOUS consent to go to Third and Final Reading on this 11th day of February 2021.

READ a Third and Final time in Council and finally passed this 11th day of February 2021.
