**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Council deems it appropriate to establish fees, fines, rates, and charges for the various bylaws, licenses, permits, goods and services, provided by the Village of Carbon; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Carbon, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Bylaw shall be cited as the Master Rates Bylaw.
2. The Annual rates, fees, and charges for various goods, licenses, permits and services shall be established as per Schedule "A", attached to, and forming part of this Bylaw.
3. The Master Rates Bylaw 2021-859 is hereby repealed.
4. That this Bylaw is passed upon third and final reading.
5. That this Bylaw shall take effect January 1, 2023.
